### Brief facts

On the 16th of March 2001 the prefecture of Jura received an e-mail in which Mr G made it clear that he wanted to challenge the local elections in his town. He later confirmed his e-mail by a letter with a manuscript signature, which he subsequently sent to the administrative court.

### Decision

The Court considered this challenge valid, although only because it had been confirmed by a letter. It seems, according to the words of the court, that an e-mail would not have been sufficient and the claim would have been considered invalid. ■
