Whereas Margarett Gawith formerly an Inhabitant in this Country & a Member off this meetinge : & off later yeeres hath had her residens Jn or about Corke Jn Irelande : Vnto w^{ch} place shee Js desirous to returne againe to liue : & make her aboade Jn :

These may therfore Certifye ffreindes off ye particular Monthly or Quarterly Meetings off Corke or elsewhere Jn Irelande.

That ye sayde Margarett Gawith hath liued amongst ffreinds Jn truth ffrom her youth vppe vnto this time : & hath behaued her selfe [*paper torn*] ye gospell in sobriety & a good Conversation & hath nott beene concerned with any as to marriage that wee euer knew, or hearde off.
