## さBe End of a Yearly Meeting

" For some years after the Revolutionary War, the meetings of the Society of Free (or Fighting) Quakers in Philadelphia were largely attended. But as years went by . . . the attendance gradually decreased until annual meetings only were held. At one of these Dr. William Wetherill, who was clerk of the Meeting, found himself and an old lady member of the Society the only ones present. After they had adjourned and he had locked the door, she said: 'William, I will not be able to come next year.' That was the last meeting of the Society for religious worship."
