A Pictorial Protest against Tithes

The pen and ink drawing reproduced here was made by a Friend about the middle of last century as a satirical protest against the injustice of tithes in the parish of Great Berkhamsted, Herts. The church is built up of various goods and chattels distrained for non-payment of the tithe. The portrait is that of John Bright.
